Part 2 Membership

Division 1 Membership generally

5 Membership provisions (CNL ss112(2), 144, 148 & 156–166)

(1) Primary activity

For the purposes of Part 2.6 of the Law, the primary activities of the co-operative are:

- (1) To build, maintain and operate a heritage railway
- (2) To promote the restoration, preservation and operation of steam locomotives and all other forms of historic transport

(2) Active membership requirements

A member must

1. Pay a regular subscription
2. Be a senior member over the age of 18 years; **or**
3. Be a junior member under the age of 18 years; **or**
4. Be a Life Member awarded by resolution of an annual General Meeting; **and**
5. Perform at least seven (7) hours of voluntary labour in a period of twelve months.
6. If over the age of 18 years, and seeking to undertake voluntary labour, submit a completed NSW Working With Children Check or equivalent interstate clearance.

to establish and maintain active membership of the co-operative.

Note. Failure to maintain active membership may lead to cancellation of membership (see rule 16).

(3) Corresponding membership requirements

A member must

1. Pay a regular subscription
2. Be a senior member over the age of 18 years; **or**
3. Be a junior member under the age of 18 years; **or**
4. Be a Life Member awarded by resolution of an annual General Meeting

to establish and maintain corresponding membership of the co-operative.

Note. Failure to maintain corresponding membership may lead to cancellation of membership (see rule 16).

6 Qualifications for membership (CNL s112)

- (1) A person qualifies for membership of the co-operative if the person is able to contribute to the primary activity of the co-operative.
- (2) Any member who is unable to perform the required hours of voluntary labour due to incapacity or distance from the museum site or fails to provide a current Working With Children Check, may be deemed, on application to the Board, to be a corresponding member.
- (3) A person's membership shall lapse if the regular subscription is not paid within three months of the due date.
